### **MOUNT PLEASANT –**

Art Reach of Mid Michigan is pleased to announce that the Mt. Pleasant Discovery Museum, the Harrison District Library, the Gladwin County District Library, and the Gratiot County Players each received a Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs (MCACA) Mini-Grant Award for fiscal year 2011.

“Sculptures for Discovery” is a program sponsored by the Mt. Pleasant Discovery Museum which received \$4,000 towards this program that will create a competition for eight sculptures that will be used to bring interest to the children’s museum. The Harrison County District Library will present “One World, Many Stories” for their summer reading program and received a grant for \$2,100. Gladwin County District Library received \$2,000 towards their “One County, Many Stories” summer reading program and the Gratiot County Players received a grant of \$2,100 for their Summer Youth Workshop.

Art Reach serves as a Re-Granting Agency for the Michigan Council for Arts and Culture. Grants are accepted for up to \$4,000 per project and are reviewed competitively. Applicants may not apply for more than half of the cost of their project. Five applications for FY2011 funds from the MCACA were received. The MCACA mini-grant program provided \$10,200 towards local projects in Isabella, Gratiot, Clare and Gladwin Counties in FY 2011.

The Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs sponsors these mini-grants as a way to make sure that local arts organizations receive support to present their programs.
